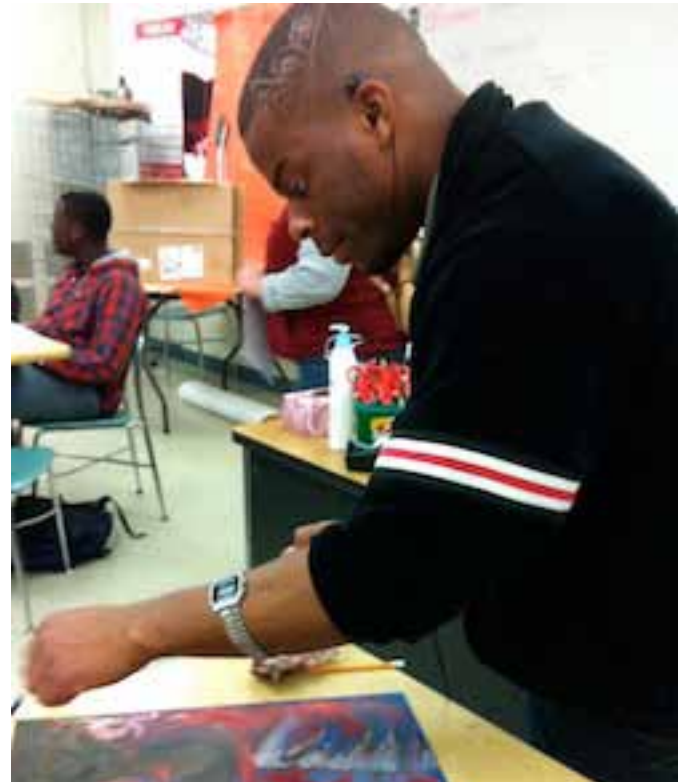

TUITION FEES at the Studio are as affordable as we can make them! They vary depending upon the length of any class session. Tuitions for adult and photography/media classes are greater because they are usually longer and class size is limited to 6.

TO REGISTER and reserve a space in a class, you must enclose full payment of the tuition fee with your registration, unless you are applying for a scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIPS Eligible students of all ages may apply for one scholarship each session. Return an application form with your registration—you do not need to include any payment until we notify you of your award within one week. Forms are available in the office or on our website.

PAYMENTS may be made in cash, check payable to Art Partners Studio, or credit card (MasterCard, Visa, Discover). Please sign the registration form to grant the Studio permission to charge your card.

WITHDRAWALS/REFUNDS Classes may not be pro-rated and there are no refunds for days not attended. A \$10 processing fee will be charged for all refunds. Withdrawals after the 1st or 2nd class will be charged for those days. No refunds are granted after the second class.

- We do not send confirmation of registration.
- Photography classes are limited to 6 enrollments; other classes to 12, unless noted.
- Art materials are in the tuition fee, unless noted.
- Classes may be canceled due to insufficient enrollment (in this case, a full refund is given).
